We are privileged to have a wonderful speaker on a hot topic (in more ways than one!) at WEPA's Annual General Meeting coming up next Tuesday. The meeting will deal with the tabling of annual reports and the nominations of the Executive Committee for 2019/20* and we will then hear from:

Speaker: Professor Lesley Hughes on *Climate change: where are we and where are we going?*

Distinguished Professor of Biology and the Pro Vice-Chancellor (Research Integrity & Development) at Macquarie University. Her research has mainly focused on the impacts of climate change on species and ecosystems. She is a former Lead Author in the IPCC's 4th and 5th Assessment Reports, a former federal Climate Commissioner and is now a Councillor with the Climate Council of Australia. She is also a Director for WWF Australia, a member of the Wentworth Group of Concerned Scientists, the Director of the Biodiversity Node for the NSW Adaptation Hub and a member of the expert advisory committee for Future Earth Australia.
